

hire terms & conditions

1. A non refundable deposit of 20% must be paid when booking in any equipment. If deposit is not paid equipment cannot be guaranteed available.
2. The hirer accepts full responsibility for the product during the hire period, (as soon as it leaves Top Dog Entertainment's care until it is returned) & indemnifies Top Dog Entertainment for any loss it may have as a result of this hire agreement, and agrees to pay Top Dog Entertainment the replacement cost of the goods listed if they are damaged in any way.

The hirer will keep the equipment in good repair and condition throughout the hire period and will comply with all instructions for the use of the equipment which are notified to the hirer by Top Dog Entertainment at the time of equipment collection or drop off.

The hirer will keep the equipment safe and protected against adverse weather as well as against risk of loss or theft while at the hirer's premises. The hirer will not use the equipment except for the purposes for which it is supplied by Top Dog Entertainment.

The hirer will immediately notify Top Dog Entertainment of any damage occurring to the equipment during the hire period.

If the equipment is damaged or breaks down during the hire period through no fault of the hirer, Top Dog Entertainment will endeavour to repair or, at its option, replace the equipment

with suitable alternative equipment. However, Top Dog Entertainment will only replace the applicable equipment if it has alternative equipment available at the time. The hirer will indemnify Top Dog Entertainment for loss of or damage to the equipment while it is under the control of the hirer. The hirer will also indemnify Top Dog Entertainment against any claims or proceedings arising in respect of personal injury or death of any person or damage to any property, which arises out of the use of the equipment during the hire period. These indemnities will extend to any loss which is covered by Top Dog Entertainment's insurance.

Any damage repair or replacement of equipment will be debited from the credit card supplied by the hirer.

The hirer is responsible for obtaining all consents and authorisations that are needed to enable the hirer lawfully to use the equipment at the hirer's premises.

The hirer will, at their own expense, install the equipment and provide all services and works to enable the equipment to be used at the hirer's premises.

3. The hirer will not assign, sublet or part with possession of the equipment during the hire period.
4. If any hire equipment is not returned at the designated time, the Customer agrees to pay Top Dog Entertainment the full cost of one additional days hire plus any Costs incurred by Top Dog Entertainment.

5. All Hires must be paid for IN FULL prior to dispatch of Hire if they are not on an approved account.
6. Proof of Identity with name, address & license number must be supplied prior to the dispatch of any hire. A photo copy of current driver's license will be photocopied by Top Dog Entertainment.
7. Under no circumstances can hire equipment be picked up in trailers (unless fully enclosed) or open vehicles.

Unless delivery is arranged between Top Dog Entertainment and the hirer, the hirer will collect the equipment from Top Dog Entertainment's premises at a specified and arranged time and date, and return the same equipment in the same condition within 24 hours of it being collected for a daily hire. All other hire durations will be stated between Top Dog Entertainment and the hirer.

If delivery is arranged between Top Dog Entertainment and the hirer, Top Dog Entertainment will deliver the equipment to the hirer's premises at a specified and arranged time and date, and collect the same equipment in the same condition within 24 hours of it being delivered for a daily hire. Transportation and delivery costs and the costs of redelivery of the equipment will be payable in addition to the hire charges where applicable.

8. All prices are for overnight hire. Weekly hire on most items is charged at 3 times the Daily Rate.
